

## **Some Examples For Your Three Things List Might Include...**

Liven up your Club website (Do we even *have* a Club website?)

Update your Club's contact information on the TI website! PLEASE! Hint: They can't join you if they can't find you!

Participate as a functionary at an Area Contest, Division Contest (timer, judge, etc)

Volunteer to help out with your Division duties at a District Conference (Decorating, Registration, Program, etc)

Plan a social event outside the Club (wine tasting, attend a concert, skydive, etc)

Ensure every new member is assigned an active mentor. "Active" being the key here.

Have a joint meeting with another club .

Lead by example – plan on finishing an Education Level (CC, ACB, etc) by June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Gather past magazines, slap a label on it and distribute them to potential members.

Secretaries – always get the "Free Stuff" from TI when placing an order

VPM - Make up a New Member Initiation Ceremony

VPE - Plan a Birthday celebration for your Club's anniversary

VP PR – Get an article placed in your local paper

Presidents of Corporate clubs – Ensure that your HR department recognizes your members' achievements. Presidents of Community Clubs - send letters to a member's employer when members achieve.

Sgt At Arms – Redo your forms – are you handing out third generation photo copies to guests?

Treasurers - Allow members to pay dues online with PayPal
